Principles

Objectives

- develop and sustain a culture of shared responsibility for the environment
- maintain a clean and tidy environment
- dispose of rubbish appropriately
- keep the College free of graffiti

Implementation

i) Principal commitment

The Principal is responsible for ensuring that:

- the objectives of this policy are integrated into practice
- appropriate staff are employed to clean school areas as required
- suitable equipment is provided for maintaining the learning environment

ii) Staff commitment

Staff are responsible for ensuring that:

- community members are educated about the importance of sustainability
- the school environment is left neat and tidy
