# Integrated Studies

Integrated Modules combine the curriculum from different

- general capabilities
- learning areas English, Religious Education,
   Science, The Arts and Humanities (History)
   Geography
- Cross curricular priorities



# Integrated Studies

#### Involves

- learning through experience inquiry based,
   negotiated and student centred
- applied and authentic learning experience
- actioning learning



# **Expectations**

- general and academic expectations are the same
- the campus is well resourced e.g. ICT, local area
- excursion forms
  - need to be signed or students cannot participate in off-campus activities



#### **Outdoor Education**

#### Two compulsory Outdoor Education experiences

- St Mary's Campus Camp
  - Completed as a part of SMC orientation overnight stay
- o Goulburn River system Canoe trip:
  - Completed in conjunction with the Sustainability Unit (4 day trip)



#### Student Travel

- morning:
  - Board bus from main campus after 8.35 am
  - Arrive at St Mary's after 8.50 am
- afternoon:
  - Board bus from St Mary's campus at 3.05 pm
  - Arrive main campus at 3.20 pm.
- students can be dropped off and picked up directly "but not preferred"

# Enhanced Subjects at Year 9

- Mathematics (Enhanced)
- English (Enhanced)
- Need to complete appropriate application form (see Ms Tamburro for advice)



# Higher Study Eligibility

- May study a Year 10 subject (500 mins)
- Time management is important
  - Will have to 'catch-up' with missed time
- Need to complete <u>Higher Study Application</u>
  - Form (see Ms Tamburro for advice)



#### VCE Choices in 2018

- Most students will complete 1 unit of VCE Religious Education
- For other VCE subjects, students must have a 80 % or above for all Learning Tasks and for all subjects in Semester 1, Year 9 (2017)
- Consider if you need to complete a Year 10 subject whilst in Year 9



#### **Attendance**

Consistent attendance at school is vital if students are to reach their potential

Year 7 → 10

90 % attendance is required

VCE / VCAL

95 % attendance required to pass the subject



#### **Attendance**

- Attendance less than 80% (Approved or unapproved) will result in an 'N' for that unit
- VCE / VCAL 95 % attendance required to pass the subject



#### **Attendance**

- Year 7 10 90 % attendance is required
- Consistent attendance at school is vital if students are to reach their potential
- Attendance less than 80% (Approved or unapproved) will result in an 'N' for that unit
- VCE / VCAL 95 % attendance required to pass the subject



#### Advice to students

- Keep selections broad, especially if unsure of your future pathway
- Select subjects:
  - Personal interest not because of a friend
  - Known ability and past success in a particular area of study
  - Career aspirations
